## In June of 2022 we commissioned 5 new Storm Drains and another DOT Box



The artists were chosen via a public Call for Art in a juried selection process, from over 20 entries submitted by qualified local artists.

This project has been gratefully funded by a Port of Los Angeles Community Grant and a grant from the Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs.





Along with the painted storm drains, we replaced a DOT Box at 6th and Mesa, funded by a grant from the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council.

This brings the total number of painted storm drains to 7, along with 25 artist painted DOT Boxes and 3 large scale murals.




















The Arts District's streets are lined with artists' live/workspaces and each month they open their doors for the FirstThursday ArtWalk, in operation since 1997.
